

END OF YEAR ASSESSMENTS IN YEAR 6

Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests 2019

Below are our results from the SATs taken by our Year 6 children in May 2019. The results are compared to 2017/18 and to schools nationally. All children in Year 6 take tests in reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) and maths, and their teachers assess their writing over a period of time for writing (teacher assessment).

Year 6 test results:

The children are judged as either meeting the expected standard for Year 6 or not. 86 children took the tests at Lowe's Wong, below are our school results and the Year 6 results nationally.

Children are also judged on whether or not they have met the expected standard in reading, writing and maths combined.

Lowe's Wong Anglican Methodist Junior was 20% above the figure achieved nationally.
